Candy and costumes are great, but there is more than one way to appreciate the Halloween season. We've thought up some additional Halloween activities your family can enjoy:

Scavenger Hunts

Scavenger hunts can be a great adventure for children. Get creative and make up a scavenger hunt. Have a friend or partner hide and be the "treasure" the clues lead to. Divide into groups so no one is running around outside in the dark alone. If young children are playing, assign each team a grown-up captain.

Flashlight Tag

Play tag at night, but participants carry flashlights so they can be seen and can see around them.

Lantern Making

Lantern making is a fun crafting idea and a great way to decorate for a party. Simply take some brown or white paper lunch bags and cut fun shapes and designs into them. Put a little bit of sand into the bottom of the bag and place a battery operated candle in the base.

*It's important to modify activities depending on age or ability of your children. Parent supervision is necessary for each activity listed. Talk to your children about safety during the Halloween season in order to ensure everyone has a fun time."
